We have received and reviewed the electronic ticket test files submitted by the vendor of your choice, Total Computer Group, and have found the form and format of the submitted materials to be sufficient to be approved for certification by the NY State Police, NYS Department of Motor Vehicles, NYS Office of Court Administration and NYS Department of Transportation.
